4. What are the first two things that Aunt Alexandra discusses upon her arrival at the Finch House? Are these typical of her or not?
5. Comment on Aunt Alexandra's ideas about breeding and family. Why does Atticus tell them to forget it? Who do you believe is right?
6. In your opinion, is Atticus' explanation of rape suitable for an answer to Scout?
7. Explain the differences between Calpurnia's point-of-view and Aunt Alexandra's point-of-view.
8. What is the "nightmare" that now descends upon the children?
9. How does Jem react when Atticus tells him to go home, and why? What does this tell the readers about how Jem's character is developing?
10. Comment on the way Scout affects events at the end of Chapter 15 without realizing it at the time.
