

Chapter 6

This chapter bridges multiple parts of the story. It connects the Harvey Oberst section of the murder investigation and chapters developing the Endicotts/Duena Mantoli.

→Virgil interviews Oberst. Oberst's racism apparent at start (61)

→Questioning about Dolores Purdy. "None of your business. She's a white girl." And "Don't you give me any of your lip, black boy. You ain't nobody and you ain't never going to be nobody. High school or college don't make you white and you know it." (62)

→Tibbs gets story of Purdy and her exhibitionism (66)

→Virgil Tibbs concludes that Harvey Oberst only took the wallet and did not murder Mantoli (66)

→Sam goes back to Endicott house but meets Kaufmann (68)
