For this assignment you and your partner will be assigned a topic to research. Each topic is related to the novel. You will collect and organize information on this topic and present it to the class. Follow the steps below to complete the project.

1. Find a Partner

There may be groups of three provided that all topics are covered by the class. If need be partners will be assigned.

2. Get a Topic

Each group will be assigned one of the following topics:

→ Civil Rights Movement → Martin Luther King, Jr.

→Life in the 1960s →Investigating Murders

→ School Segregation and Integration → Racism in the American South

→ Movies and TV Based on the Novel → Teen Pregnancy

→The State of North Carolina →Crime Fiction

3. Research Topic

Use the Internet to find *reliable* information on your subject. You should be looking for the following:

→What your topic is all about → Details and information to explain your topic

→Important dates and events →Important People →Illustrations, maps, graphics and pictures about your topic

Websites like Wikipedia will be useful but using a search engine like Google or Bing will also help you find information on your topic. Ensure you write down all websites you use!

4. Organize a Visual Element (on Bristol Board)

Create a Bristol Board-sized poster that organizes the information your group has researched. Ensure that the information is organized clearly and effectively, and that it covers the research topics listed above. Information needs to be written in your own words and any websites used need to be referenced on your poster. (See Sample Visual Element)

5. Class Presentation

Each group will present their information to the class, (a 3-4 minute presentation) and explain their topic and important information.

Students will be given **TWO DAYS** to complete the research, organization and visual elements of this assignment. Students will begin presenting on the third day.
