## What is a short story?

Short stories are simple forms of **fictional narratives**, (made-up stories). They are different from other types of narratives because of the following:

 $\rightarrow$  Brevity (Shortness) - They are less than 20,000 words (80 pages)

 $\rightarrow$ Uncomplicated plot - Very straightforward beginning, middle, end

 $\rightarrow$  Few Characters - Only necessary characters in story.

 $\rightarrow$ Conflict Solved - Story aims to come to simple conflict resolution

 $\rightarrow$  Focus on **Plot** and **Conflict** - Main problem drives the story

## SETTING:

 $\rightarrow$ Setting includes **where** and **when** the story occurs. This may be specific information or there may be clues, (i.e. how characters act, what they wear, the season, etc.)

## CHARACTERS:

 $\rightarrow$ Anyone directly involved in the story. They are divided into the following types:
